

For the past few days, our students have been rehearsing the project they will present at the school in Budapest during recess. We are so excited!










Strolling through Budapest




WEDNESDAY 4th

So now i can say I have been in Hungary twice.






Visiting Esztergon

Imagine stepping out onto a balcony and seeing two countries, one on each bank of the Danube? Hungary and Slovakia.





SHOES ON THE BANKS OF THE DANUBE.

This memorial commemorates the 3,500 people, 800 of them Jewish, who were shot on the banks of the Danube during the Arrow Cross terror.

They were ordered to remove their shoes (valuable items that could be stolen and resold by the militiamen after the massacre) and were shot at the water's edge so that their bodies would fall into the river and be swept away. The memorial depicts their shoes left on the bank.




Esztergom



Incredible views


This afternoon we went to see Buda Castle and from there and from Fisherman's Bastion we saw some great views of Budapest and its illuminated parliament building




UNIVERSAL LANGUAGE

EVALUATION



I had a great time this week. I'm looking forward to March so I can see our partners again!!!


